Water allocations for the Lower Gwydir groundwater source

NSW Water Commissioner, David Harriss, today announced the available water determinations for groundwater sources in the State's north-west for the new 2013/2014 water year, commencing 1 July 2013.

An allocation has been made for each category of access licence in the water sharing plan for the Lower Gwydir groundwater source.

Local water utility and domestic and stock licence holders will receive an allocation of 100 per cent of entitlement.

Aquifer access licence holders will receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share of entitlement, while supplementary water access licence holders will receive an allocation of 0.286 megalitre per unit share of entitlement.

Supplementary water access licence holders are reminded that the maximum amount of water they are permitted to take under their supplementary water access licence from this water source in a water year, is the allocation resulting from the available water determination(s) for that water year.
