## Commencing water allocations for the Lower Gwydir groundwater source

NSW Water Commissioner, David Harriss, today announced commencing allocations for groundwater sources in the State's north-west for the new 2012/2013 water year.

The new water year began on 1 July 2012.

An allocation has been made for each category of access licence for the water sharing plan for the Lower Gwydir groundwater source.

Local water utility and domestic and stock licence holders will receive a 100 percent allocation.

Aquifer access licence holders will receive an allocation of 1 megalitre per unit share, while supplementary water access licence holders will receive a 0.429 megalitre allocation per unit share.

Supplementary water access licence holders are reminded that the maximum amount of water they are permitted to take under their supplementary water access licence from this water source in a water year, is the allocation resulting from the Available Water Determination(s) for that water year.

Supplementary water allocations in the Lower Gwydir groundwater source may only be taken at any time and at any rate, in accordance with the Supplementary Water Order made under section 70 of the *Water Management Act 2000*.
