The site: A 25 year old macadamia orchard on Emigrant Creek with large areas of sheetwash.

The outcomes:

- improved water quality leaving the orchard
- · less water entering the orchard
- surface water directed to dam or grassed areas.

The project

The project aimed to divert water draining from neighbouring property before it entered the orchard. Works were undertaken as follows:

- windbreak between the two properties removed and mulched
- broad shallow diversion bank constructed
- excavated soil used in low profile mounds along the adjoining eroded tree rows
- carpet grass and millet sown in all areas
- erosion control matting installed in drainage lines.
